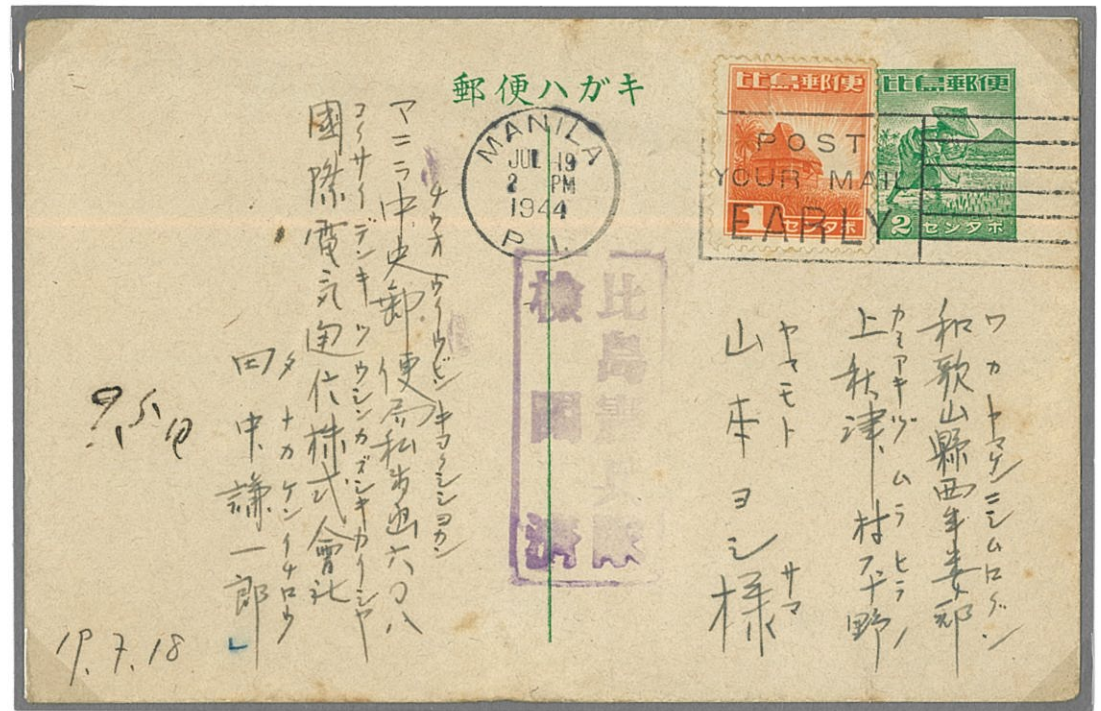


1C and 2C stamp on private postal card

## 1C additional franking on 2C Regular Postal Card

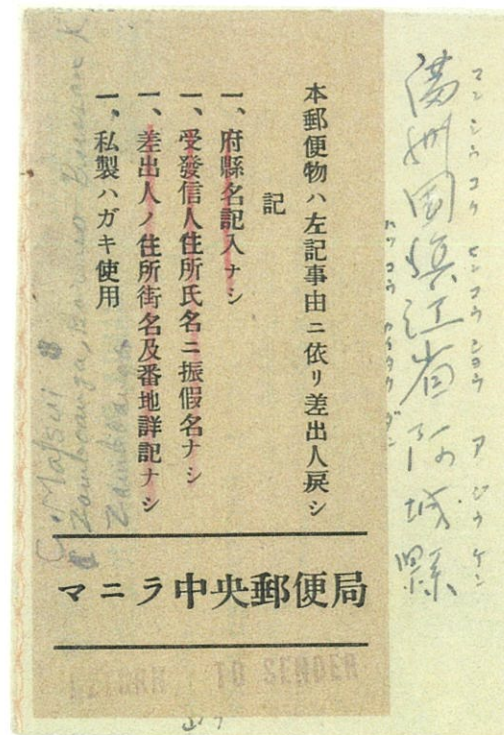


Jul. 19, 1944, First Class Postal Card,  
Manila to Wakayama, Japan

Franked 1C regular stamp on 2C regular postal card for 3C proper postal rate for foreign postal card rate effective from May 15, 1944.

Properly censored in Manila for foreign mail matters  
**Scarce Usage:**

Proper commercial usages of 1C stamp on 2C regular postal card are rarely encountered.



Jun. 23, 1944, Private Postcard,  
Zamboanga City to Manchukuo (Return to the Sender)

Franked 1C and 2C stamp on private postcard to Manchukuo. But it was not forwarded and returned to the sender because use of private postcard was prohibited even if 3C proper postal rate was paid.

The attached slip, with description of the reason of return in Japanese "私製ハガキ使用" or "use of private postcard", was attached Manila central post office.

**Scarce "Returned to Sender" Slip:** Only 2 examples known.
