

Second Official Issue

A set of three provisional stamps was issued on **Aug. 28, 1944**; **5C/6C stamp** covered for first class mail rate, **20C stamp** covered for registry fee and **1P stamp** covered no relevant postal rate at the time of issue but was useful for parcel post and multiple-rate mail. These stamps were issued not only for official use but also for obtaining revenue for the sales to collectors. Therefore, most of the issues had been consumed for the philatelic purpose and proper official usages of any of the 3 stamps are extremely rare. **Quantity:** 5C/6C: 500,000, 20C: 200,000, 1P: 100,000
