**SECOND NATIONAL JAMBOREE
(Boy Scouts of the Philippines)
(May 2-8, 1961)**

The Second National Jamboree of the Boy Scouts of the Philippines was held on May 2-8, 1961, in the beautiful City of Zamboanga.

Considered in area as one of the largest cities in the world, Zamboanga is especially noted for its beautiful parks, lovely orchids and exquisite pearls. South of the Philippines, it is the best known vacation spot. Its palm-fringed beaches and natural swimming pools are among the best in the Country.

No effort was therefore spared to prepare the Pasonanca Park in Zamboanga Coty for the gathering of Scouts and Scouters that lasted for one week.

The Jamboree was a demonstration of camping skills with emphasis on fellowship. Brother Scouts, numbering 5,500, from every corner of the Philippines met and participated in a series of activities that enabled Scouts from every contingent to display their skills, witness Scoutcraft technique, learn about sectional customs and get acquainted with Scouts from other places.

For the second time, the Jamboree was a tangible manifestation of national solidarity for the interest of young Filipino boys.
