Postal authorities of the Republic of the Philippines today, 28 December 1964, issue a set of stamps in commemoration of the recently concluded 1964 Olympics, held in Tokyo, Japan. The role played by olympics in fostering and furthering international understanding and friendship is significantly portrayed on the stamps.
