The Bureau of Posts issues today, November 16, 1970 the Golden Jubilee Philippine Pharmaceutical Stamps, to coincide with the opening of the 4th General Assembly of the Federation of Asian Pharmaceutical Associations (FAPA) and the 3rd Asian Congress of Pharmaceutical Sciences under the auspices of the Philippine Pharmaceutical Association.

The founding of the Philippine Pharmaceutical Association was inspired by a memorable incident when several practicing pharmacists in Manila were sued for violating certain Pharmacy Law, but were ably defended by Prof. Filemon Tenchoco, Sr.

The enthusiasm to constitute an exclusive association of pharmacists grew with incredible celerity and strong determination until the idea crystalized into a concrete and real form, THE PHILIPPINE PHARMACEUTICAL ASSOCIATION.

It was founded on August 29, 1920 at the former Manila College of Pharmacy, Oroquieta St. corner Zurbara, Manila, with Rafael E. Carrion as the first president.
