PLANNED PARENTHOOD STAMPS

The Bureau of Posts issues today, March 21, 1971 the Planned Parenthood Stamps, coinciding with the Regional Conference of the International Planned Parenthood Federation for Southeast Asia and Oceania which will be held in Baguio City, starting from March 21-27, 1971.
