

1875 - 1877

With King Alfonso XII being proclaimed King on December 29, 1874, a new set of seven stamps featuring the head of the King facing right were issued and received in Manila between 1875 and 1877. The stamps, similar to those of Cuba and Puerto Rico, were designed by Jose Garcia Moreno, whose initials 'JG' appears on the base of the neck of the effigy. They were typographed by the Fabrica Nacional de Moneda y Timbre, Madrid and issued in sheets of 100 stamps.
