

**1878 - 1879**

A new set of ten stamps were received in the Philippine between 1878 and 1879. Similar in design to the previous issue, but with the value in milesimas de peso (ten milesimas to the centavo). The stamps were once again designed by Jose Garcia Moreno, whose initials 'JG' appears on the base of the neck of the effigy. They were typographed by the Fabrica Nacional de Moneda y Timbre, Madrid and issued in sheets of 100 stamps.
