

SEPTEMBER 1879

The Philippines changed to the new Universal Postal Union rates and procedures in September 1879. As a result, two previous stamp issues were surcharged 'CONVENIO / UNIVERSAL DE / CORREOS / HABILITADO' with the corresponding value in black. Two distinct surcharge types were applied on both issues. The first, smaller surcharge, measures 9mm vertically compared to the second, larger surcharge, which measures 12mm vertically.
