Printers Waste of the King Amadeo stamps are known with 'ULTRAMAR' instead of 'FILIPINAS' on the bottom label. The stamp values are inconsistent with those issued for the Philippines. Instead both the 'Ultramar' heading and values on these stamps align to other issues in use in Cuba during this period. Although no official Amadeo stamps of this series were issued for Cuba, these could have been intended for use but never produced due to the abdication of King Amadeo on February 11, 1873.
