Gooding #2UF1. Crude forgery in black not of any distinguishable type in the sheet of forty. Letters and numbers on top label are even and large. Virtually no space between the 'Y' and '1854' and '55'. The value '10' between 'FRANCO' and 'Cs' does not appear to exist. There are no coronets on the crown, which is formed by two diagonal lines, the top one slightly wavy. Known used with circle of dots cancellation.





Gooding #2UF2. Facsimile. Copied from a genuine stamp so showing all the correct characteristics of the Plate 1 issue including small '0' in '10'. Evident from visible pixels from printing when magnified.

Gooding #2F1. Senf Brothers Forgery. Lithographed in dark rose on modern white paper. The 'RE' of 'CORREOS' is broad and lower than other letters. A great exaggeration.
