**Gooding #5F1 (Type B).** Modern Facsimile Reproduction of the Englehardt Fohl Forgery printed in lime-green on thick paper.

**Gooding #5F2.** Issued in Orange instead of Green. No period after 'R' and 'F' of '2Rs FTE'. Fourth pearl from the top left is broken at the bottom. No horizontal staff on '5' of '1854' and the horizontal staff of '4' ends with a small blob.

**Gooding #5F3.** Crude forgery issued in light green. The diagonal stroke in 'R' in 'FRANCO' ends with a large hook. The 2 in 'Rs' is small. The 'E' in 'FTEs' is omitted, causing this to be misspelt as 'Fts'. The 5 in '1855' appears as a '6', causing date to appear as '1865'. The crown is very poorly printed, with most of the coronets very faint or partially missing.
