Gooding #6F9. A crude forgery and easily identifiable. All letters and numerals are embossed. The circle of pearls are generally joined, appearing as a continuous chain instead of individual circles.







Gooding #6F12. A crude forgery in orange. All the letters and numbers are large and of even size. None of the horizontal lines touch the outer circle or the vertical borders. The pearls are non-existent and are replaced with double lined dashes. Known used with circle of dots cancellation.
