

Gooding #18F2. Very crude forgery in deep green. 'Correos' and Value on bottom are lightly printed and broken (hardly distinguishable). The hair is lightly shaded with a lot of lines missing. The markings above the eye are not as filled as in the genuine stamp.

Address appears to be written in ballpen, which was not invented until the 1930s
