AFF NOTICE

Correspondence from the Asociacion Filatelica de Filipinas addressing concerns about multiple orders being placed by members through multiple Associations. Written from A de Lange, Acting Secretary of the AFF.

Dear Fellow Member:

The request which we are about to make is authorized by the Ministry of Public Works and Communications. In recent weeks the Bureau of Communications has found its work complicated by the amount of duplication that arises whenever reservations for stamps or postal services are made. There are now three philatelic organizations in Manila and the Bureau has found out that there are some persons who order through all three clubs. In order to cure this deficiency they have asked us to give them a certified list of all our members indicating therein their particular preference in the matter of placing their orders.

We have therefore prepared the enclosed eard wherein you are to indicate your choice. Please fill it as soon as possible and return to us. All cards must be in by July 25, 1944. In this respect we want to make it clear that members are entirely free to choose the organization they want to deal with. The mere fact that you place your order elsewhere does not necessarily mean that you lose your standing as a member of the A. F. F.

The Association's policy of charging a fee for reservations remains unchanged.
