

FIRST POSTAL PERMIT CARD

Pre-Paid 2c Postal Permit Card, Manila Circulating, with pre-printed notices on front and reverse. This is the only Postal Permit Card authorised by the Bureau of Communications during the Japanese Occupation. The Short Dividing Line on the front is constant throughout the various printings and simulated the well-known variety which occurred on a percentage of pre-war postal cards. Used by the AFF on a number of significant occasions. With Manila 'Post Your Mail Early' Slogan Cancel.
