

COMMEMORATIVE CARD - FOUNDING OF KAPARIZ

Manila Circulating Postal Card commemorating the founding of 'KAPARIZ' on the 83rd birth anniversary Dr Joe Rizal, the national hero of the Philippines. Uprated with three Rizal stamps issued during the Japanese Occupation period, tied with two 'KAPARIZ' special cachet Cancels (Number 8 Control Marking). Philippine Philatelic Club purple handstamp on Card Front. Reverse blank.



'KAPARIZ' is an acronym for '**KA**bataang **PA**ngarap ni **RIZ**al' (Children with Aspirations towards Rizal). Proclamation No. 18, issued by President Jose P Laurel on June 7, 1944, declared that June 19th of every year as 'KAPARIZ Day'.

Partial Extract from the Proclamation No. 18:

"Whereas, Ordinance No. 18, dated May 1, 1944, established the national youth brotherhood Kabataang Pangarap ni Rizal or KAPARIZ whose purpose among others is 'to instil in the Filipino youth an abiding interest in Rizal's life so that they will exert every effort to observe his teachings and follow his examples;'

Whereas, a national observance of a fitting nature of June 19, Rizal's birthday, would be an excellent means of focussing the minds of the people, especially of the young, on the life and teachings of the national hero; and

Whereas, it is but proper that such a national observance be given a timely and special meaning with respect to the Kapariz movement;

Now, Therefore, I, Jose P. Laurel, President of the Republic of the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law do hereby proclaim June 19 of this year, and of every year thereafter, as Kapariz Day, and call upon all public officials and all private citizens and inhabitants of the Philippines to observe this day fittingly and in such manner as to contribute to the furtherance of the ideals for which the Kapariz was created and established ..."
