Creation of the Junior Chapter was originally announced on August 2nd and ratified at the meeting on August 8th. The following extract from the PPC Flashes Number 9 confirms this formation:

"Junior Chapter Born: August 8 was a red-letter day for Junior Members of the PPC as our young Kasamas organized the PPC Junior Unit on that day. Too, on the same day it was 'hinged' to the PPC as Chapter No. 1. Elected as officers of the PPCJU were: Victor Ferriols, president; Manuel Zaragoza, vice-president; Fidel Ramos, secretary; Carmen Ferraz, treasurer; Jesus Razon, chairman membership committee; and Pablo Ferraz, chairman, auction committee. Leon Goldenberg, vice-prexy of the PPC and Tony Calero, an enterprising Kasama, were elected Executive Adviser and Technical Adviser, respectively, by the Junior Executive Council, to guide the young Kasamas to better philately..."
