Handwritten text stating "Stamp Collecting is not only a hobby but also an art. An art is something that fills the soul with a beautiful feeling – a sense of appreciation for things beautiful and memories so sweet to be forgotten – as for instance, a rhapsody in stamps and autographs of beautiful women." Signed Rizalino D. Arispia Sr (secret acronym abbreviated as: Rizal Declares a Revolution in Stamped Paper Is a Silent Rebellion).
