PPC FLASHES

Greetings! Kasama—  
Time flies so fast that the *PPC Flashes*, our peequency newsletter in a nutshell, seems to be always racing with Time. However, it's better late than never, as for instance—  
PEEPS & PEEKS: Members in attendance at our regular business meeting on Aug. 20, put their stamp of approval on our revised Constitution and By-Laws, signifying that everything in our CHL is peepesically oke doke... Kasama Zobel's lecture at our last meeting was a wow... Kasama H buzzed into the PPC ears re somebody's "philatelic funeral"... Life begins at 40, so Kasama E celebrated his 40th birthday anniversary last Aug. 17 in a philatelic way... Because of the last General Defense Drill (Aug. 25-27), the Society of Philatelic Rizalists which was supposed to be organized last Aug. 26, held its organization meeting last Aug. 24 and elected a Provisional Council headed by Kasama "Dulo" Protomartir. Inauguration and general election of officers of the SPR will be held on Sept. 19, at 2 p. m. at the PPC quarters, Goldenberg Bldg... Souvenir cards were distributed by the Society of Philatelic Rizalists on Aug. 29, on the occasion of the PPC Benefit Auction for the Jose Rizal Memorial Fund. Total proceeds from the Benefit Auction amounted to P1,012 which our Club has donated to the JRMF... The *Philatelic Ticker* kid sister of the *PPC Flashes*, made its debut on Aug. 28, with Kasama Luna on the helm. Digesting it reveals that its main purpose is to serve as a barometer of prices in the stamp trade with a particular mention on the present wartime philatelic market... New set of "K.P." stamps was issued by the Bureau of Communications on Aug. 28. Values are 5c, 20c, and 1-P, and bear the overprint "Republika ng Pilipinas" and "K.P." First-day covers were treated with a special circular postmark bearing the inscription, "MANILA—AUG. 28, 1944—FOR PHILATELY," together with these stamps, a new 2c "K.P." postal card bloomed on Aug. 28 and bears the same overprint as per supra... Constitution Day or First Anniversary of the Constitution of the Republic was commemorated by the Bureau of Communications with a special postmark on Sep. 7. On the same day the 50c stamp of the Kalibapi Issue (Apr. 30/43 to you), was re-issued... Our New Issue Service Committee or NISCO for short, is preparing a check list of varieties discovered by them on the recent "K.P." issue. As soon as 'tis ready, we shoot it in the *PPC Flashes*... The Philippine Stamp Exchange of which Kasama Vicente Arias is the Master, celebrated its First Anniversary on Sep. 2. Souvenir cards were distributed by the Master of the PSE... Kasama K tells us that a crook broke into his house the other night and among the things looted was the manuscript of his lecture which he has under steked to give at the meeting of the PPC... Kasama Luis G. Miranda is gonna give an extemporaneous talk at our regular meeting on Sep. 17... Reservations for available pre-war stamps made by collectors through the different philatelic clubs are now being distributed by Kasama Leon Goldenberg, vice-prexy of the PPC. Next distribution for orders or reservations placed late, will be made as soon as the first distribution is accomplished. Kasama JG has been duly authorized by the Bureau of Communications to handle the distribution of the pre-war stamp reservations in the interest of philatelists and philately, remember!—
