

WHAT DO YOU THINK?

Anyway, there is a frenzied buying fever and we do sincerely feel sorry for a number of philatelists that we know who are trying to complete their collections under the present abnormal price situation.

Analyzing the present report, the total catalogue value of foreign stamps we have listed is 929.19 and the total sale is 5042.
