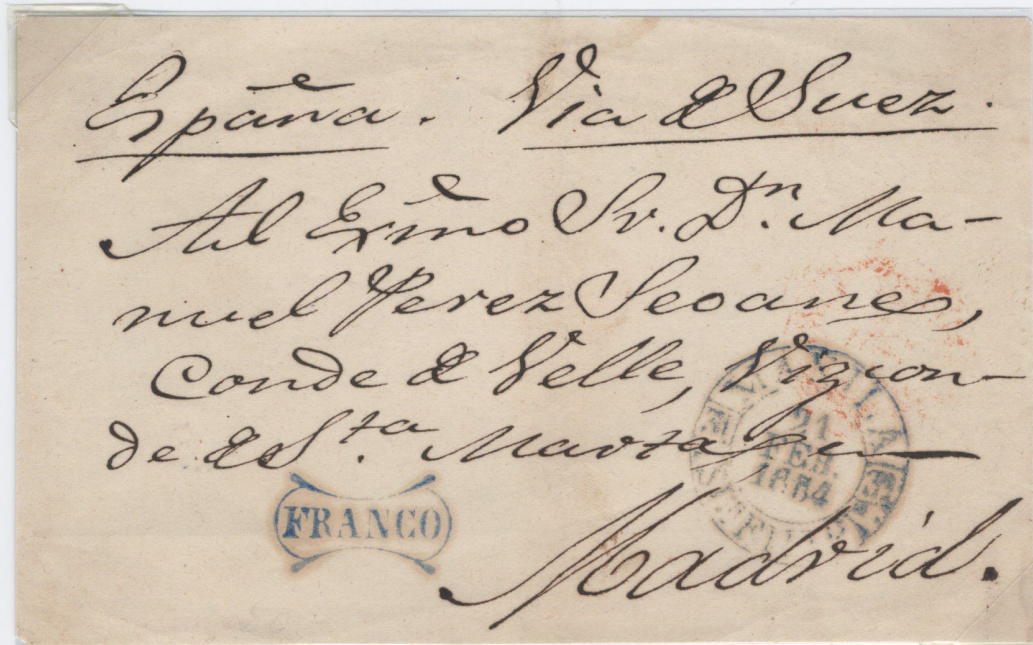


1854 STAMPLESS COVER – STAMPED ERA

AUTHORIZED FOR OUTBOUND MAIL
PENDING THE ARRIVAL OF SPANISH MADE ADHESIVE
BLUE “FRANCO” with BLUE “MANILA – 31 – ISLS. FILIPIS.” CANCELLATION
(29.5mm in Diameter)



6 Reales – Single Outbound Rate to Spain
via Isthmus de Suez and Algeciras (Gibraltar)
Manila to Madrid February 21, 1854

To Countries which had no Postal Treaties with Spain
BLACK “MANILA – 31 – ISS. FILIPIS.” CANCELLATION
(28mm in Diameter)



Subject to 4 pence Local Hong Kong Rate
Manila to Hong Kong February 8, 1861
Although mail was handled by the Philippine Postal Authority, Philippine adhesives
were not affixed. This is due to invalidity of Philippine adhesives to countries where
Spain had no postal treaties
