## 1868 - 6-2/8c Habilitado Por La Nacion Block of Four



## SOLD

PTS11-02. Scott \#36. Used Block of Four with two lightly struck Parrilla cancels. Cut into on left on both stamps. Habilitado Por La Nacion overprint applied Vertically, reading upward. Scarce to find in multiples. Fresh and appealing.

## Spanish-Philippines

## 1873 - 62c Rose King Amedeo Unissued Stamps



## SOLD

PTS11-03. Edifil NE3. 62c Rose (Mint, OG, HR) and corresponding stamp (Mint, NG, HR) with "Ministerio de Ultramar / Muestras" (Specimen) Overprint. This stamp was not officially issued and withdrawn due to the abdication of King Amadeo on February 11, 1873. Odd blunt perf noted, otherwise a nice duo. Scarce and much sought after.

## Spanish-Philippines

## 1883 - 1r on 200m Green Surcharge Era Stamp



PTS11-04. Scott \#129. Mint (OG, HR). 1r red surcharge on 200m Derechos de Firma stamp. Average centring with fresh colour and a nice centrally struck surcharge. Very minor foxing on a couple of the perfs on left noted for accuracy. Scott Cat $\$ 600$.

## Spanish-Philippines

## 1896 - 8c Red-Brown Alfonso XIII on Cover to Germany



PTS11-05. Scott \#162. Commercial cover from Manila to Eltville, Germany with 8c Alfonso XIII issue tied with February 1896 "Correos - Manila" circular date stamp, paying single weight UPU rate to Germany. Eltville (28 April 1896) Receiving circular date backstamp. Minor opening tear on top, not affecting stamp. Nice cover.

## Aguinaldo Period

## 1898 - 25c Black Libertad Complete Papel Sellado



## SOLD

PTS11-06. Warren W-336. Unused complete two page Papel Sellado (Documentary Stamped Paper) measuring $22.5 \mathrm{~cm} \times 32 \mathrm{~cm}$ issued during the Aguinaldo uprising (No. 21311). "Hacienda Timbre Nacional / Filipinas" circular embossed mark on top left and "J Vilaseca" watermark. Common edge creasing and some minor edge toning noted. Very scarce and seldom seen as a complete document.

1899 - US 10c Forerunner on Cover to England

PTS11-07. US Scott 273. 10c US stamp used on cover from Manila to Streatham Common, London, England, tied with 28 July 1899 Military Station No. 1 Duplex cancel. Streatham (30 August 1899) receiving circular date backstamp. Common edge and corner wear otherwise a striking cover. Very scarce usage.

## US Occupation

1902 - US 2c Stamp on Domestic Cover


## SOLD

PTS11-08. US Scott \#295. 2c US stamp used on Manila circulating mail, paying single weight domestic rate, tied with Manila (16 January 1902) Duplex cancel. Interesting usage. Two other covers recorded with this stamp, one domestic from Cebu to Manila and one from Tacloban to USA. US postal issues were sold in the Philippines from July 30, 1898 and June 30, 1899 and were valid for use until October 1, 1903.

## 1899 - 2c Red Booklet Pane of Six

PTS11-09. Scott 214b. Used. 2c Red booklet pane of six (missing top selvedge) used with circular dotted cancels (unusual). Fresh, vibrant colour. Seldom seen used in (almost) intact state. Very scarce. Scott Cat \$300.

1900 - 10c Brown on Cover to USA


PTS11-10. Scott 217. 10c Brown Regular issue on Registered cover from Manila to New York, USA, tied with Military Station No. 1 (10 August 1900) Duplex cancel. Rectangular Boxed Registration handstamp on front (No. 5741). Partial (24 September 1900) San Francisco registry division backstamp. Back flap missing. Couple of filing folds not affecting stamp. Scarce usage.

1906 - Domestic Cover from Laguna to Manila

PTS11-11. Scott \#226, 229, 230. Domestic Cover from Santa Cruz, Laguna to Manila with total of 10c postage, tied with Santa Cruz (10 February 1906) Duplex cancels. Cover endorsed "Cuartel Milicia" (Military Headquarters) on bottom left. Manila (11 February 1906) Receiving backstamp. Addressed to Captain F L Palmer, one of the early researchers of Philippine philately who wrote a couple of invaluable reference books on Philippine philately. Very scarce.

1917 - 2c Rizal Booklet Pane on Cover to Australia

PTS11-12. Scott 290 (2), 290e. 2c Rizal Regular issues (2) and complete Booklet Pane on cover from Santa Cruz, Davao to Tooraweenah, New South Wales, Australia, all tied with Davao (28 June 1930) Duplex cancels. Tooraweenah (22 July 1930) Receiving Circular Date stamps on front and reverse. Generally fine and very scarce complete booklet pane usage on cover.

## 1929 - Booklet Pane Stamps on Domestic Cover to Manila



PTS11-13. Scott 290e, 291 (2). Domestic Registered cover from Santa Cruz, Davao to Manila with split Booklet Pane into two strips of three (no top selvedge) on reverse and two 4c Regular Issues on front, all tied with Circular Star cancels. Rectangular Boxed (7 December 1929) Davao Registration handstamp and scarcely seen Davao registration label (No. 3545) on front. Manila (14 December 1929) Registry Section receiving circular date backstamp. Common edge wear, otherwise a lovely and scarce cover.

## 1938-1p Small Commonwealth Complete Sheet

PTS11-14. Scott \#443 (25). Mint (OG, NH). Complete sheet of 25 of the 1p Small Commonwealth issue. Fresh and very fine.

## US Occupation

1945 - 2c Rizal Victory Perforation Error


## SOLD

PTS11-15. Scott \#485 (4). Mint (OG, NH, but skipped on half of right stamp). 2c Rizal Victory issue with Crazy Perforations due to natural paper fold during the perforation process. Top right stamp partially imperf on right corner with diagonal perfs into right margin. With "C" imprints on top margin. Striking error.

## 1926 - Madrid-Manila Stamps on Cover to England



PTS11-16. Scott \#C3-C6, C9-C12. Commercial Registered long cover from International Banking Corporation, Manila to Ealing, London, England. Rectangular Boxed Manila (20 May 1926) Registration handstamp on front and back. Ealing (7 July 1926) Receiving circular date backstamp. Heavy vertical filing fold on left not affecting stamps. Very scarce and a showpiece. Scott Cat $\$ 850$ for used singles.

## Philippine National Bank Circular OB Handstamp



## SOLD

PTS11-17. 2c Rizal Regular Issue (Perf 11). Mint (OG, NH). Left Margin Block of Four with Philippine National Bank Circular OB Handstamp (12mm Diameter). Very fresh and well centred stamps. Notation on left margin plus Walter Bruggmann "W.B. Manila" handstamp. Stated to be the only mint block known. Great specialist lot.

## Uprated USA PSE from Manila to USA



PTS11-18. US Scott U379, 220. United States issued Pre-Stamped Envelope used in the Philippines with 4c Regular Issue uprated to pay 5c fee, with Manila No. 5 (28 March 1904) Duplex cancel. Manila to Birmingham, Alabama, USA. Centre vertical filing fold and some minor toning and common edge creases. Birmingham (7 May 1904) receiving machine backstamp.

## 1900 - 2c Uprated Pre-Stamped Envelope to Germany



PTS11-19. Scott U8, 213, 214. Uprated Pre-Stamped Envelope from Manila to Erfurt, Germany uprated to 5c to pay single weight fee, tied with Military Station No. 1 (19 February 1900) Duplex cancels. Generally fine.

Registry Return Receipt


PTS11-20. Unused Registry Return receipt (No 9-665) in use during the US and Japanese Occupation periods. Some foxing noted. Seldom Offered


## SOLD

PTS11-21. Scott \#N3, N6, N7. Two First Day Covers with Manila (30 April 1943) Duplex cancels. First on cover with printed cachet on bottom left. Second on PreStamped envelope (Scott \#NU1) with "First Day Cover" Handstamp on bottom left corner. Both with rectangular boxed censor handstamp. Very fine and nice combination covers.

## Japanese Occupation

1945-5s Laurel Perforated Proof


## SOLD

PTS11-22. Scott N37. Mint (NG, as issued). 5c Laurel single Perforated Proof stamp. Fresh and well centred. Scarce.

The first public announcement of the Bureau of Communications stated that the Laurel stamps were to be issued perforated and gummed. It is apparent that the Bureau attempted to perforate the stamps, but the poor quality of the paper combined with the dullness of the pins in the perforating machine made the task impossible to achieve. Examples of the 5s value are found perforated (12x12-1/2), without gum, and are proofs looted from the vault of the Manila Central Post Office during the battle for the liberation of Manila.
