2. All items are priced and sold in US dollars.
3. All lots are sold on a first-come first-serve basis, based on time-stamp of received email.
4. Please quote the reference number(s) and corresponding price(s) for any items of interest and email to: nvkstamps@hotmail.com or nigelgooding@hotmail.com.
5. Confirmation of availability and a corresponding invoice will be sent within two (2) days of receipt of any requests.
6. Postage and shipping will be added and detailed in the invoice. Standard Airmail charged at \$4.00 for orders under \$50. Due to recent experiences of unpredictable postal conditions, Sales over \$50 will be sent via registered mail and Sales over \$300 will be sent via DHL, unless otherwise agreed with the buyer. Registered or DHL charged at cost.
7. Payment options:
 - Paypal - no fee to apply if sent using “Family and Friends”, otherwise a surcharge will be applicable to cover the Paypal fee (details provided with invoice).
 - US or UK Cheque to be made out to Velda Gooding.
 - Direct Deposit to US, UK or Australian bank (details will be provided with invoice).

FEATURED LOT

1890 – Telegraph Receipt with Forged 5p Stamps



PTS12-F. 1890 Telegraph Receipt for message sent from Manila to London. Telegraph stamps cancelled with 18 April 1890 Correos / Manila circular date stamps. Forged Block of four of the 5p Telegraph stamp (top left stamp damaged on top). These forgeries were created and used to deceive the government and are one of very few known forged stamps actually used during the Spanish Period. Very scarce and rarely offered, moreso on original document. A single 5p forged stamp was offered at 500 Euros by a Spanish Auction house earlier this year.

1859 – 5c Queen Isabella Block of Six

PTS12-01. Scott 10. Mint (OG, HR). 5c Block of Six displaying Types 2, 1, 2 / 4, 3, 4 with the four varieties of this issue on the right block. Vertical tear on left edge running down both stamps. Fresh colour and scarce issue in large multiples.

PTS12-02. Scott 13. Mint (NG). Fresh colour with commonly found tight perforations for this issue. Couple of light marks on top right and small nick on bottom right just clear of frame line. A scarce stamp and hard to find very fine. Scott Catalog \$190.

1864 – 12-4/8c Queen Isabella Block with Official Usage

PTS12-03. Scott 23 (4). 12-4/8c Blue block of four used with somewhat smudged Official cancel. Four average to good margins, clearing all frame lines. Fresh appearance. Repaired vertical tear between bottom two stamps, otherwise a very nice multiple, scarce as such.

PTS12-04. Scott 129. Mint (Dry OG, HR). 1r red surcharge on 200m Derechos de Firma stamp. Base stamp centred top right with fresh colour and a nice centrally struck surcharge. Scarce stamp. Scott Cat \$600.

1898 – 2c Red Aguinaldo Revolutionary Issue

PTS12-05. Scott Y1. 2c Red Used with manuscript (pen) cancel. Fresh deep shade with good to better pers. Lovely centring for this issue. A really lovely looking stamp and much sought after. First one we have had to offer for a couple of years. Scott Cat \$300.

Aguinaldo Period

1898 – 2c Aguinaldo Revolutionary Block Used



PTS12-06. Scott Y3 (4). 2c Red (pale shade) Block of Four with lovely crisp Albay Katipunan cancel. Two vertical manuscript (pen) line cancels, commonly cancelled as such on fiscal documents. Fresh and well centred stamps. A choice item and great show piece.

1899 – US 5c & 15c Forerunners on Cover to USA



PTS12-07. US Scott 273. 5c and 10c US stamps used on cover from Manila to Pasadena, California, USA. Both stamps tied with Military Station No. 1 15 May 1899) Duplex cancels. Indistinct wax seal on reverse with Pasadena (27 June 1899) Receiving circular dated backstamp alongside. Roughly opened on sides and some foxing noted. Very scarce cover with use of the 15c stamp. Great Military Station specialist cover.

2c Rizal Regular Issue with OB Handstamps

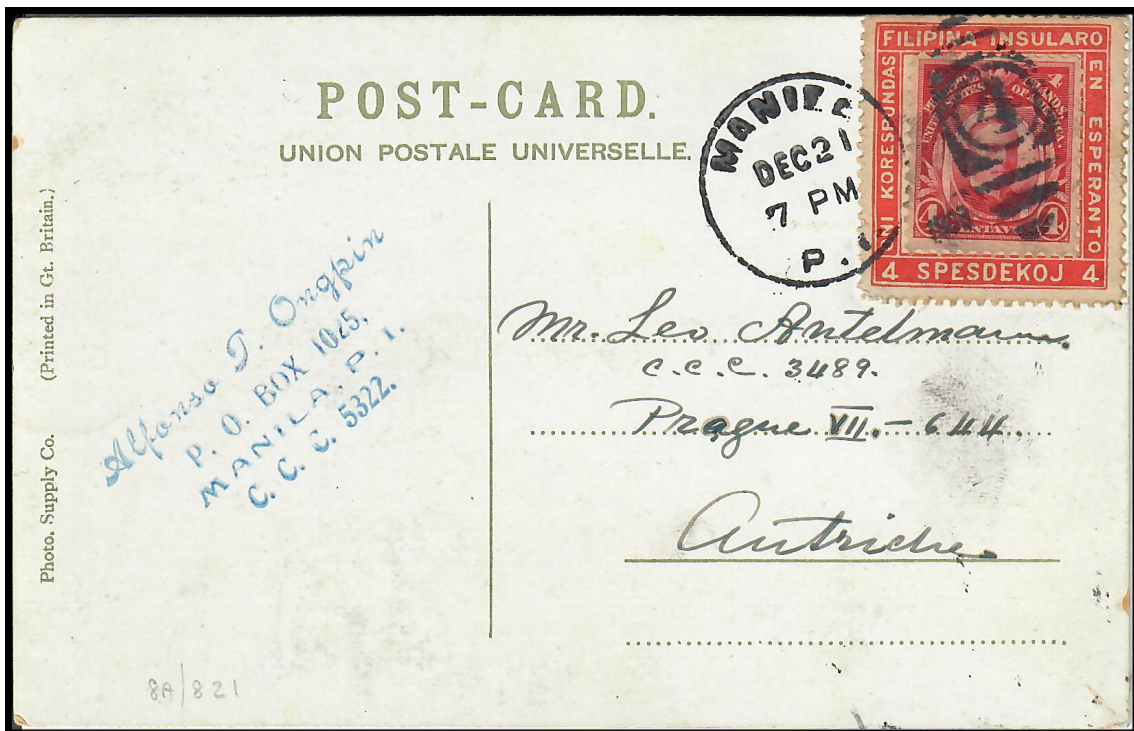


PTS12-08. 2c Rizal Regular Issue (Unsorted). Small box rammed with stamps, all showing handstamp OB overprints. Estimated to be well over 1,000 stamps. A great opportunity for sorting with some scarcer handstamps included. High retail value as observed from sales on ebay. All guaranteed genuine as acquired many years ago from a renowned dealers stock.

1908 – Postal Card with 4c Esperanto Seal



PTS12-09. Scott 242. Postal Card from Manila to Prague. 4c Red Esperanto Seal with corresponding 4c Regular Issue affixed to centre, both tied with Manila (21 December 1908) No. 4 Duplex cancellation. Card featuring the Parian Gate and View of Entrance, Manila. Minor edge fault on bottom right, otherwise fine for this period. Rare use of the much sought after Esperanto issue.

1945 – 2c Rizal Victory Perforation Error

PTS12-10. Scott 485 (4). Mint (OG, NH, but skipped on parts o left stamps). 2c Rizal Victory issue with Crazy Perforations due to natural paper fold during the perforation process. Bottom right stamp partially imperforate on right corner with crazy perforations into right margin. Striking error.

PTS12-11. Scott J5. Mint (OG, HR). 50c Deep Claret with fresh, deep colour. Good perms and very well centred for this issue. A choice stamp and seldom offered so fine. Scott Cat \$250.

1928 – First Flight Cover with Lambert Imperf Stamps



SOLD

PTS12-12. Scott 345a (2). First Flight Cover for non-stop flight between Manila and Zamboanga via three US Army Air Service planes on 20 June 1928. Originally addressed to Postmaster in Dansalan, forwarding to Zamboanga (misspelt on cover). Only 43 covers carried on this flight. Various transit and arriving backstamps. Very scarce use of 12c Imperf Lambert pair, stated to be the only known used 12c Lambert Pair with Plate Number. Some foxing and odd stains noted for accuracy. AAMC-29.

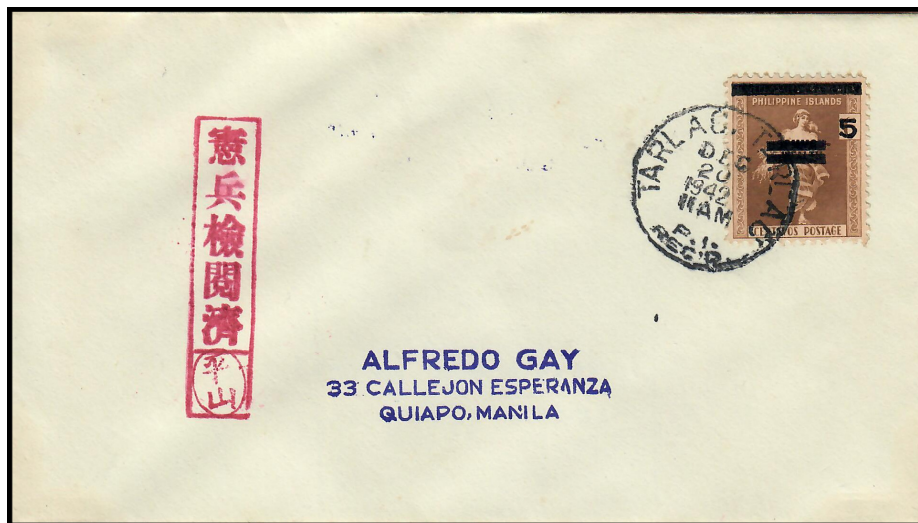

Stamp tied with Tarlac (20 December 1942) Circular Date Stamp with red vertical Tarlac Censor Handstamp (Garrett IC13), with censor officer circular seal on bottom of censor chop. Generally fine condition. Scarce usage.

1942 – Red Cross Semi-Postal Set Imperforate Proofs



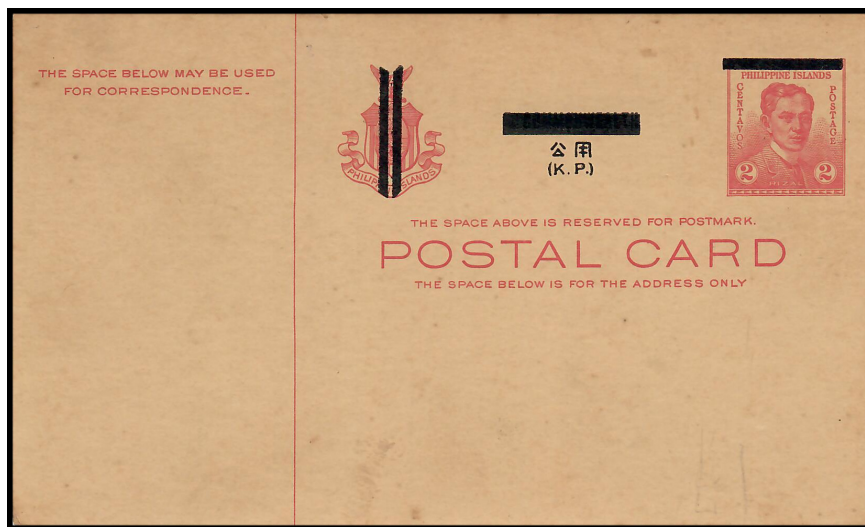

PTS12-19. Scott 927 (50). Mint (OG, NH). 30c Full sheet of fifty stamps showing ultramarine of tie shifted left, varying degrees throughout the sheet. Plate 1A1A1A. Fresh and very fine. A great showpiece. Scarce to obtain in full sheet. Much sought after issue. Priced at only \$1.50 per stamp.
