Adolf (Don Adolfo) Roensch was born in Hamburg, Germany on December 14, 1829, and was married to Margaretha Magdalene Hulsz. He was a milliner (person who designs, makes, trims, or sells women's hats). The earliest records show Adolfo Roensch & Company, a hat manufacturer, established in 1873 and located near downtown Plaza Sta Cruz, Manila at Escolta 21 and Escolta 71-75 from the latter part of 1903.

A Branch House was also established at Calle Real in Iloilo from the mid-1870s. Earliest records found to date show this was established in 1877. However, an 1875 advertisement claimed that 'the same items sold in Manila would be available at the Adolfo Roensch branch in Iloilo' (los mismos articulos encontrara el public en su sucursal de Iloilo).

The company expanded over the years to include military effects, Army and Navy uniforms and accessories and supplies, a wide range of clothing and accessories as well as musical instruments. 1892 records show the inclusion of Adolfo's son, Alfred (Don Alfredo) Roensch, as assistant and later promoted to manager from around 1898. Adolfo Roensch passed away on November 27, 1901. It is assumed that Adolfo Roensch & Company continued to operate until it was formally taken over or acquired by Alfredo where he started trading under Alfredo Roensch & Company from around 1903, initially occupying the premises at Escolta 71-75.

Staff changes noted. Manila: Adolfo Roensch (absent), Otto Roensch (hat manufacturer), C Staude (assistant), E Quade (assistant), M Beetz (assistant), Ramon Crescini (assistant). Iloilo Branch House managed by J Hagemann.

1888

Staff changes noted. Manila: Adolfo Roensch (absent), Otto Roensch (hat manufacturer), Ramon Cresicini (assistant), O Sievers (assistant), J Thiessen (assistant). Iloilo Branch House: Emilio Roensch (hat manufacturer).

1889

Adolfo Roensch & Company expands business as hat and military effects and musical instruments manufacturer. Manila staff: Adolfo Roensch (absent), Otto Roensch (hat manufacturer, absent), O Sievers (hat maker), J Thiessen (assistant), Ramon Crescini (assistant). Iloilo Branch House: Emilio Roensch (hat manufacturer).

1892

Adolfo Roensch's son, Alfredo Roensch, joins the company as an assistant. Other staff: Adolfo Roensch (absent), R Roensch, Ramon Crescini, Narciso Monfort, Otto Roensch (absent). Iloilo Branch House: Emilio Roensch, Oskar Roensch.

1894

Staff changes noted. Manila: Adolfo Roensch (absent), Alfredo Roensch (assistant), Ramon Crescini (assistant), Narciso Monfort (assistant), Alfredo Arce (assistant). Iloilo Branch House: Emilio Roensch (manager), Oskar Roensch (assistant), Walter Roensch (assistant).

1898 - 1899

Alfredo Roensch takes over as manager of the business. Manila staff: Adolfo Roensch (absent), Alfredo Roensch (manager), Ramon Crescini, C Clausen, R Walter, Alfredo Arce, J Gomez. Iloilo Branch House: Narciso Monfort (assistant), Felipe Mediavilla (assistant).

1902

Staff changes noted. Manila: Adolfo Roensch (absent), Alfredo Roensch (manager), Ramon Crescini, C Clausen (assistant), Alfredo Arce (assistant), J Gomez (clerk), D Conde (assistant). Iloilo Branch House: Felipe Mediavilla (assistant), M Nevado.

No further records have been found for Adolfo Roensch & Company after 1904. It is assumed that Adolfo Roensch's business interests were acquired or inherited by his son, Alfredo Roensch, as early as the latter part of 1903. Soon after, records indicate that Alfredo started trading under Alfredo Roensch & Company, occupying the same premises as Adolfo Roensch & Company. Earliest reference to Alfredo Roensch & Company is based on a domestic cover dated 14 October 1903, addressed to the firm at Escolta 71-75, Manila.






