Pedro Javier y Rodriguez is first recorded in 1876 working as a pawnbroker with Martinez & Rodrigues Company, pawnbrokers and commission agents. Martinez & Rodriguez Company was located at Binondo 17, Manila with the following staff members: R S Javier Martinez (pawnbroker), Pedro Javier y Rodriguez (pawnbroker), J Rodriquez (assistant) and E J de Leon (assistant).

Between 1879 and 1882, Rodriquez and Martinez are shown working for Roxas, Reyes & Company, merchants and agent for Singer Manufacturing Company. Staff include: F L Roxas (merchant), M de los Reyes (merchant), Pedro Javier y Rodriguez (merchant), R S Javier Martinez (clerk), J de las Cajigas (clerk), J Mijares (clerk) and F Reyes (clerk).

It appears that F L Roxas takes over the business of Roxas, Reyes & Company from around 1885, with no further records found of M de los Reyes from 1885. F L Roxas & Company are listed as a merchant and ship agent, with the following staff recorded in 1885: F L Roxas (merchant), Pedro Javier y Rodriguez (clerk), R S Javier Martinez (clerk), C Gloria (clerk), F Herrera (clerk) and Rufino Santillan (clerk). Pedro Javier y Rodriguez remained employed with F L Roxas as a clerk up to 1893, and then as a Custom House Agent through to 1897. These dates align with handstamps found by Pedro Javier Rodriguez as a Custom House Agent on stamps issued between 1891 and 1896.

No further records from 1898 have been found for Pedro Javier y Rodriguez or F L Roxas & Company.
