ANTONIO SAINZ

No specific information has been found about Antonio Sainz. Based on the fiscal stamps used with his business handstamp, it is most likely he was employed by the Government to manage fiscal related activity between the early to late 1890s. Handstamps to date have been seen on Recibos y Cuentas fiscal stamps, which were used to cover the tax fee of 10c applicable by law on each receipt or paid invoice.
