Batlle Hermanos (Brothers) and Company was most likely established in the early 1880s. In 1882, records show the company as merchants and bankers, located at Calle Real 27, Manila. Staff included Evaristo Miguel Batlle, Geronimo Martinez (cashier), and C Manotoc (accountant). In 1885, both Evaristo and Joaquin Batlle appear as proprietors of the company, located at Calle Real 37, and supported by a staff of eight employees.

Between 1888 and 1894, records show the company managed by Joaquin Batlle and Tomas Garcia Ruiz. In 1888, Batlle Hermanos and Company took up residence at Pasage de Perez, Escolta.

The company moved to Calle Real 4, Intramuros in 1889 where it remained until end of the 19th century. In 1899 Evaristo Batlle y Hernandez, M Henry and R Genato are shown as managers of Batlle Hermanos and Company.

The company remained active into the early part of the US occupation. In 1902, records show Batlle Hermanos and Company located at the 'Batlle Building' at Rosario 70, Manila, managed by Evaristo Miguel Batlle y Hernandez and Evaristo Ricardo Batlle y Alvarez (son) and supported by: A Javier (accountant), JM Salgado, D Javier, M Gomez, J Barroga and A Cuenco. No further records have been found after 1902.


