BENEDICTA JAVIER CATALINO VALDEZCO

Catalino Valdezco, a watchmaker and printer, was proprietor of the business 'Relogerio de Catalino Valdezco' located at Real 23, Manila between 1879 and 1885. Records in 1885 show that he is joined in the business by Jorge Valdezco, possibly his son. No further records after 1885 are found for Catalino and it is assumed he passed away in 1885 or soon after. The handstamp indicates that he was married to Benedicta Javier, the widow of Catalino Valdezco (viuda de C Valdezco).

Records between 1888 and 1894 show that Jorge Valdezco remained in the printing business, running a 'Bazar y Imprentar' located at Real 18, Manila. No further records have been found beyond 1894.
