

BLOCH Y GREIN

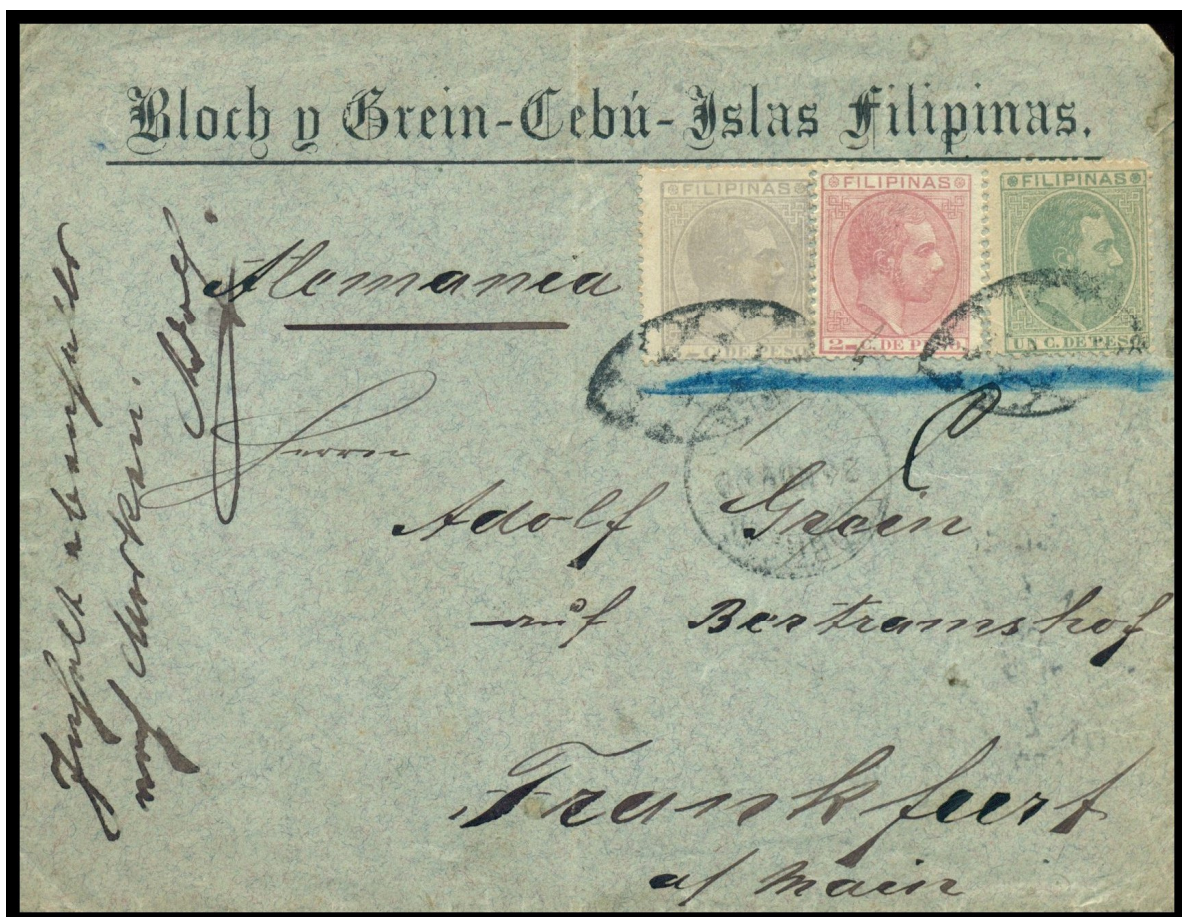
Bloch y Grein, trading as 'Bazar Visayas' was an import company operating in Cebu between the late 1880s to mid-1890s. Records in 1892 and 1894 show Emilio Bloch and Federico Grein as proprietors of Bloch y Grein, along with assistants Alfredo Schwab and Eurique Weil. The company supplied a diverse range of products including: jewellery and imitation jewellery; watches; esoteric effects; paper, books and envelopes; granite sewing machines; instruments and music boxes; metal cutlery; and glassware and tableware. No further reference is made about Bloch y Grein from 1898 records.

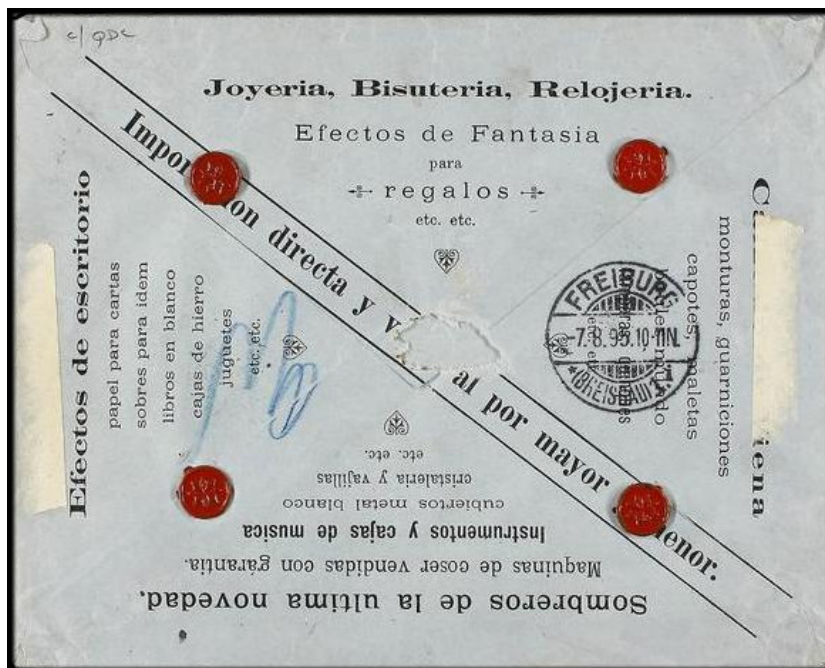
