
BOTICA ANTIGUA

Botica Antigua was a pharmacy in Cebu from 1892, believed to have been established through the acquisition by L Santos of the Cebu pharmacy of Botica de Santa Cruz, previously owned by Pablo Schuster. L Santos is recorded as proprietor between 1892 and the late-1890s. Records in 1899 show Dr Andreas Krapfenbauer as proprietor of Botica Antigua, supported by A Pereira. Botica Antigua, a pharmacy and factory producing soda water (fabrica de aguas gaseosas), was located at Calle Maria Cristina, Cebu.

Andreas Krapfenbauer commenced work in Manila in the early 1880s working for Jacobo Zobel, a chemist and druggist located at Calle Real 13. Records show him as an assistant at Jacobo Zobel between 1882 and 1885. In 1889, Andreas Krapfenbauer is shown working as a chemist at Pablo Schuster's Botica de Santa Cruz located at Goiti 8, Plaza de Santa Cruz, Manila. Between 1892 and 1894, Andreas Krapfenbauer worked for Teodoro Meyer y Cia, trading as Farmacia y Droguera de Santa Cruz (pharmacy and drugstore), located at Plaza de Goiti, Manila. Sometime between 1895 and 1898, Andreas moved to Cebu. In 1898, records show A Krapfenbauer, Farmacia and in 1899 Andreas Krapfenbauer takes up the role as proprietor of Botica Antigua.

Between 1901 and 1917, Andreas Krapfenbauer is recorded as proprietor of Botica Antigua, which moved premises to Calle P Burgos. The business is noted as a pharmacy, drugstore and soda water producer (Farmacia, Drogeria y Fabrica de Aguas Gaseosas). Between 1905 and 1908, Andreas Krapfenbauer is supported by H Deininger as manager of the Botica. From as early as 1908, Botica Antigua is also referred to as the Cebu "German Dispensary".

In 1909 H Deininger is replaced by Paul Krapfenbauer, pharmacist and son of Andreas Krapfenbauer, who also remains with the Botica up to 1917. Between 1912 and 1917, the company, as well as retaining its position as a pharmacy and factory producing soda water, is recorded as being a drugstore wholesaler. The last records found to date show the Botica still in operation in 1922 with Dr Andreas Krapfenbauer as president and Paul Krapfenbauer as chemist and manager. Paul Krapfenbauer migrated to the United States with his son, spending his last years in Washington. Andreas passed away in Spokane, Washington on October 24, 1958.

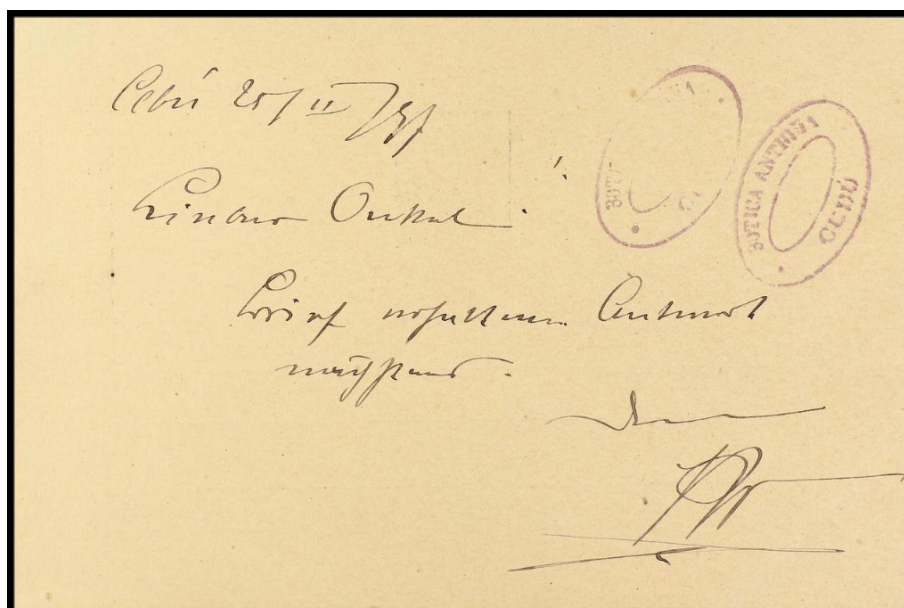

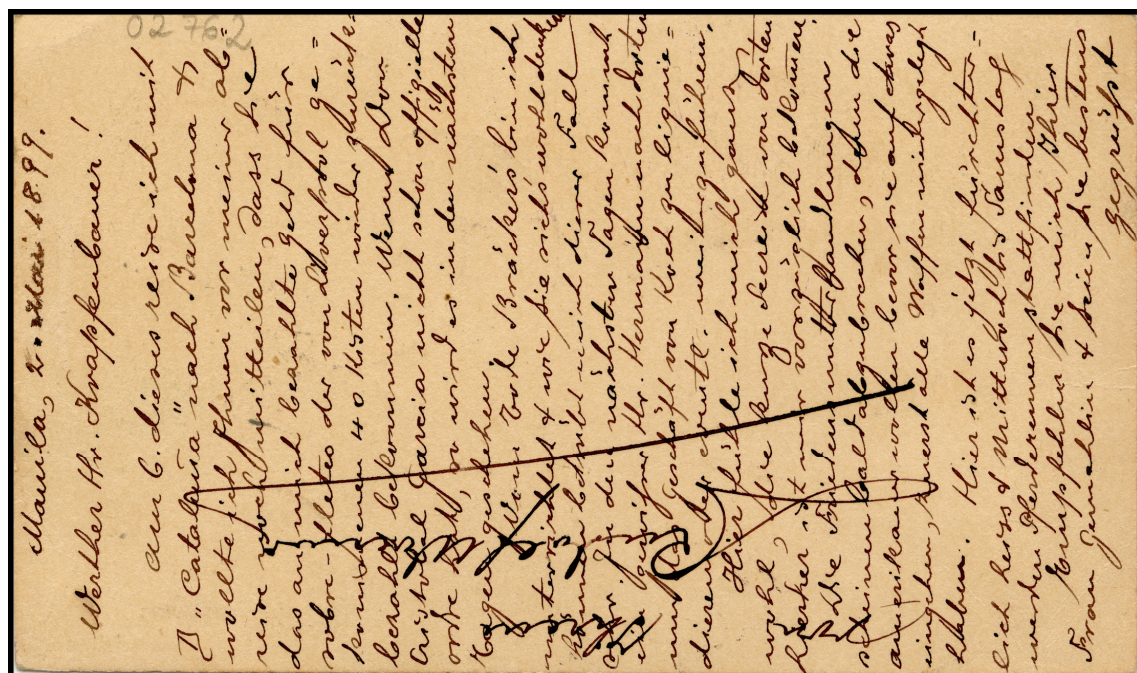

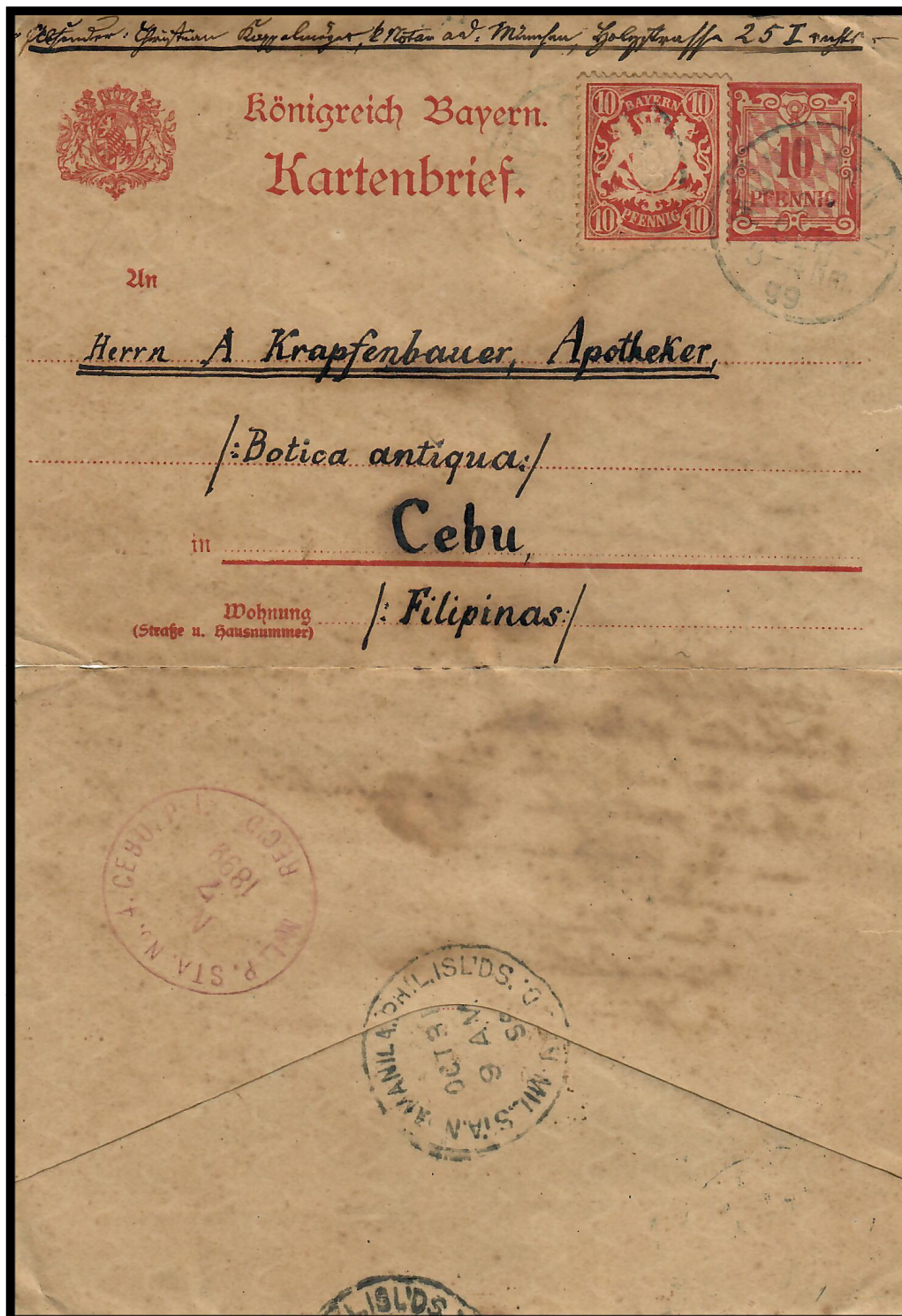

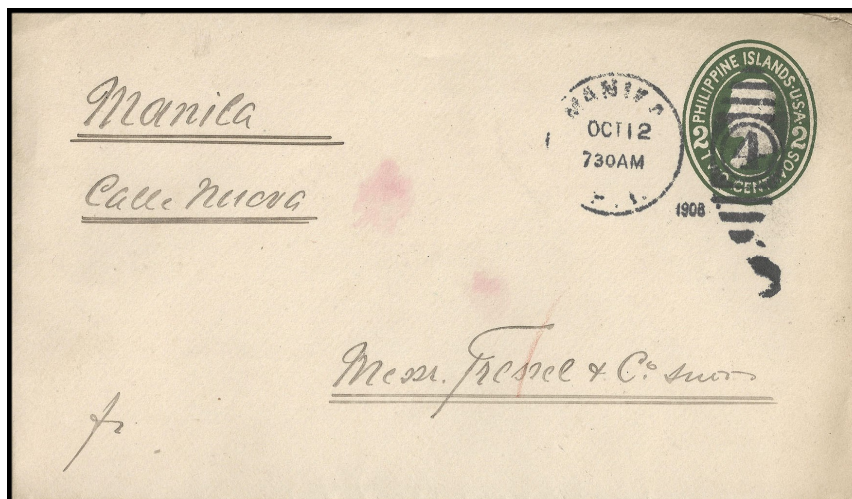

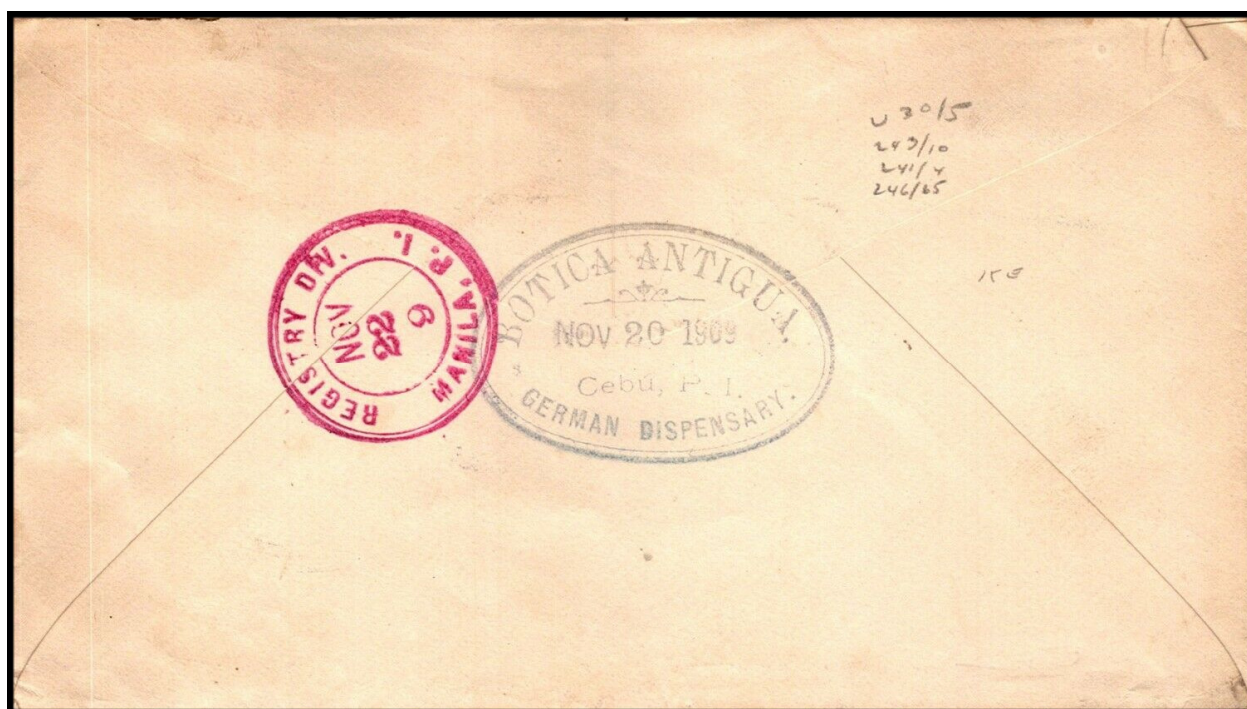
