

CAMILO GRANADOS

The only record found to date for Camilo Granados is in 1898, where it shows him working as an assistant for the Subinspeccion de Armas Generales del Ejercito de Filipinas (Philippine Army General Arms Sub-inspection). A notice in the Gaceta de Manila (11 February 1890) confirms the issuance of land property title in favour of D. Camilo Granados in Juban, Albay (about 30km southwest of Sorsogon City).
