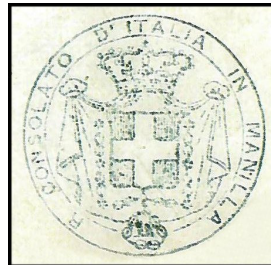

Circa 1880 – Stampless Cover from Manila to Bacolor (Pampanga)

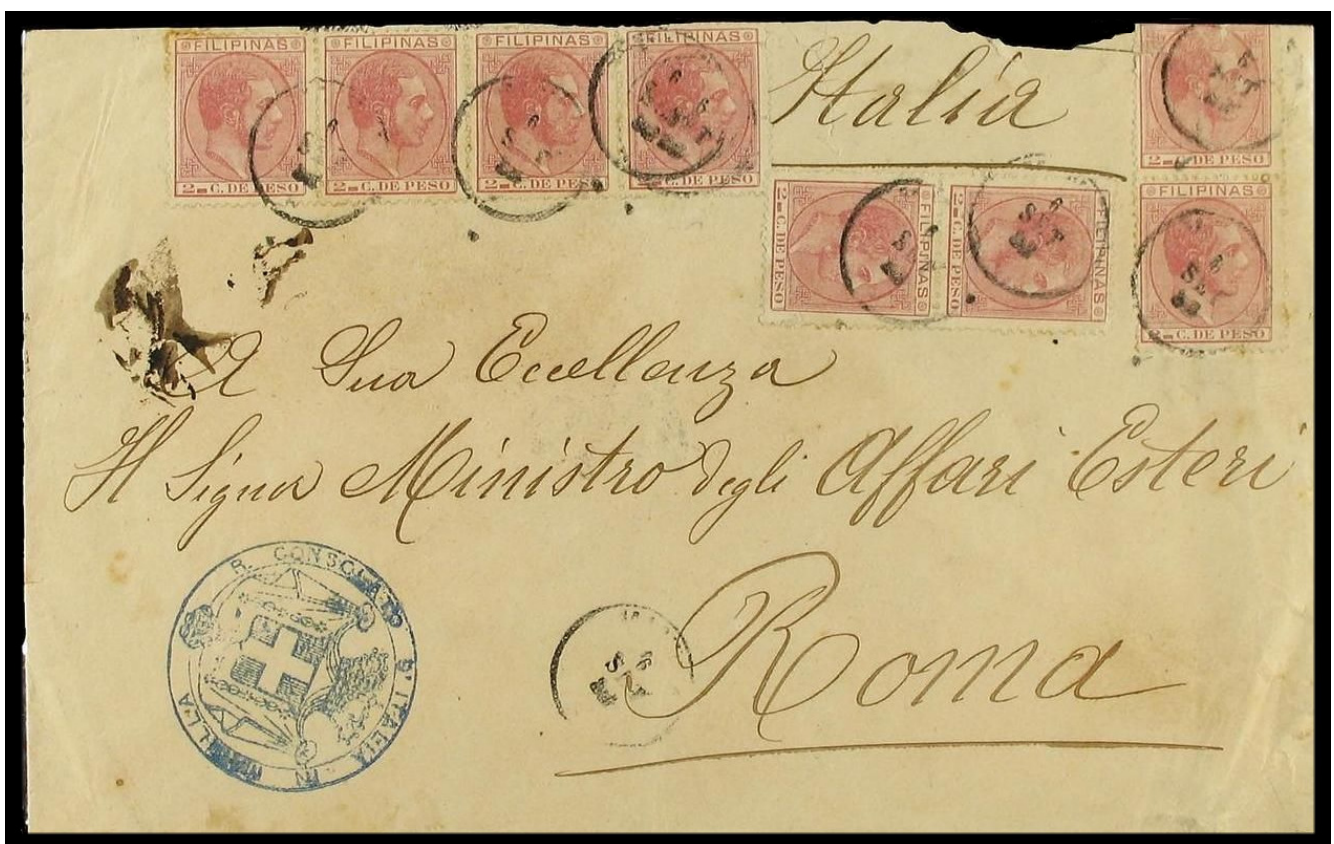
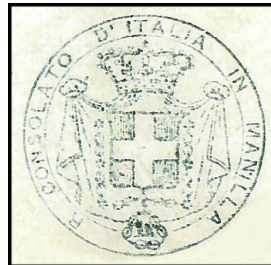

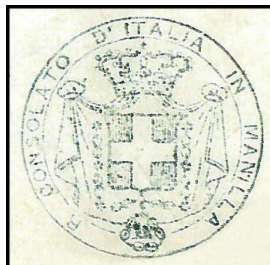
Eight 2c Stamps Paying 16c Double Weight Rate to UPU Country with Manila Star Departure CDS

16 December 1886 – Cover from Manila to Rome, Italy

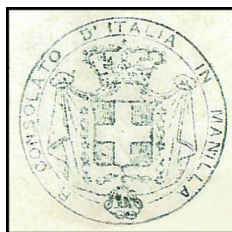
Four 2c Stamps Paying 8c Single Weight Rate to UPU Country with Manila Star Departure CDS

Two Vertical Slits on either side indicating cover was subject to Disinfection or Fumigation
