J CODINA AND COMPANY

Juan Codina is known to have worked as a merchant between the mid-1880s and early 1890s. 1888 records show Juan Codina in partnership with A Sans and F Pedreño operating as Sans, Codina y Pedreño, a merchant and shipping agency located at Calle Barcelona 3, Binondo, Manila. In 1889, it appears that Sans and Codina take over the business, now appearing as Sans y Codina, retaining the same address and product line. A Further change in 1890 shows the company now trading as J Codina y Cia, with A Sans relocated to Barcelona. No further records of the business or Juan Codina have been found after 1890.

The three companies operated under the same guiding principles, establishing companies in Manila Barcelona, Spain. They focused on importing various goods from Spain and exporting fruits and products of the Philippines, as well as acting as a retail agent on a commission based structure. Reciprocally, the Barcelona operations were focused on exporting conserved wines and other Spanish products as well as importing goods from the Philippines, India, China, Japan and Australia.


