PEDRO PAIG

No records have been found to date on Pedro Paig. Based on stamps used with his business handstamp, it appears that he was employed as a notary between the mid to late 1850s and late 1890s. Most likely employed by a Government Agency or an Ecclesiastical Department to perform duties such as witnessing of signatures, preparing copies of paperwork, or the authentication of documents.
