

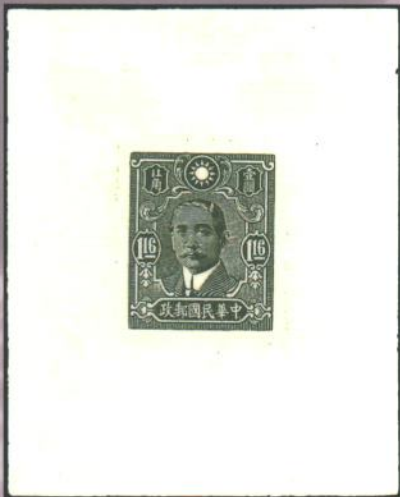

3761

1869-1971 mint and used collection on album leaves and stock sheet with part sets only prior to Q.E.II, but with some useful stamps, including 1888-97 mint to 25c. and 50c. and used to 32c., some faults in earlier, later generally fine to very fine, duplication (hundreds). *Not illustrated.*

3763 - **UNSOLD**

1880 envelope from Manila to Hong Kong (7.10) "Per 'Diamante'" bearing "Convenio Universal de Correos Habilitado" 8c. on 100m. carmine tied by "Manila/\*" c.d.s., with "Hong Kong/A" arrival c.d.s. on reverse, very fine and very rare (8 centavos UPU single-weight letter rate to overseas, non-Spanish countries). Only four covers recorded with this adhesive. Scott 73.

HK\$ 18,000 - 22,000

With the adoption of UPU rates on 1 September 1879, four King Alfonso XII "Convenio Universal de Correos Habilitado" surcharges were issued that day for the new rates.

3764 - **SOLD \$5750-**

1884(c.) envelope to Balangiga, Samar Island, bearing 1881-88 "Habilitado Para Correos" 2c. on 10c. bistre, variety surcharge inverted, tied by parillas cancellation, backflap removed and reduced at left, trivial tiny corner perf. fault, very fine usage, the only known cover with this inverted surcharge. Scott 112 var.

PHILIPPINES

3762 - **UNSOLD**

1862 entire letter to Manila (11.4) bearing 1859 5c. vermilion (2, each with ample to large margins) cancelled by circle of dots cancellation (indicating different, smaller town origin), with right example also tied by "Manila/Isles. Filipis/31" double-ring arrival d.s., splitting along folds, very fine and scarce usage (10 cuartos double-weight interior rate). Scott 10.

3765 - **UNSOLD**

1884(c.) envelope to San Jose, Antique Province, bearing 1881-88 "Habilitado Para Correos" 2 4/8c. on 10c. bistre tied by parillas cancellation, showing scarce framed "Correos" h.s. (with additional strike on reverse), backflap and part of back removed, scarce. The "Correos" handstamp was applied in small towns where c.d.s. were not available in the 1880s and 1890s. Scott 113.

3766 - **SOLD \$5175-**

1881 (28 July) envelope ("C. Fressel & Co./Manila" imprint on flap) from Manila to Hamburg, Germany (3.9) bearing 1881-88 "Habilitado Para Correos" 8c. on 2r. blue tied by parillas cancellation, "C. Fressel & Co./Manila" red sender's h.s. adjacent, fine and very attractive. Scott 116.
