

"NOT IN SCOTT"

Here are four examples of stamps not listed in Scott, each from a different period of Philippine Philately. The stamps are from the collection of the editor.

The stamp depicted in **FIGURE 1** is Scott No. 10 overprinted with the "Habilitado Por La Nacion" handstamp used on other early Spanish Philippines stamps listed in Scott as numbers 25 to 38. Scott number 10 is not one of the stamps listed as having received the overprint. An article by **DON PETERSON** entitled "Newly Discovered 'Habilitado Por La Nacion' overprint on 5 Cuartos Issue (Scott #10)" was published in our Journal, Vol. XVI, No. 3, Third Quarter, 1994. In that article, Don pictured a used copy of this stamp from his collection, indicating it was the only example of which he was aware. This is the second example known. The stamp was declared genuine in a certificate from the APS Expertizing Service in 1996.
