KENNEDY MEMORIAL ISSUE

In 1968, a set of five stamps and two miniature sheets in memory of John and Robert Kennedy was prepared by an American Agency under contract with the Philippine Postal Authority. At the last moment, this contract was cancelled by the Philippine Government. In the meanwhile, the stamps had been put on sale in the USA but they were not issued in the Philippines. The stamps have no postal validity despite later attempts to have the stamps validated. They were never put on sale at Post Offices in the Philippines.
