Gooding #1F3. Printed in orange. The '5' in '1854' is taller than the other numbers. The second '5' in '55' is very narrow and has virtually no loop. The bottom loop of '5' in '5 Cs' ends in a dot. Wide margins between stamps.

Gooding #1F5. Issued in dull red-brown. The 'Y' in the top description is positioned to the left and touches the '4' in '1854'. No evidence of the circle of pearls on the top left corner. Known used with a bogus Small Baeza circular date stamp.



Gooding #1F4. A Crude imitation Red (shades) with coarse lined background. Letters and numbers are of even size. 'FRANCO' is well away from the left frame line. Diagonal scratch from top of eyebrow to right vertical frame line. Used with Araña cancellation and probably produced in Spain.
