Gooding #16F2 - Senf Brothers Forgery. Typographed on stout, extremely wove paper. The letters of 'CORREOS' get larger from 'C' to the end, so that the 'S' almost twice as large as the 'C'. This is a great exaggeration of the genuine. The letters 'NT' of 'INTERIOR' are considerably larger than the rest. There is no period after 'RI'. Some stamps exist with the word 'FALSCH' printed in blue just above the lower label. Known to exist unused and used with parallel bars in an oval.



Gooding #16F4. Dangerous forgery in purple and also issued in shades of orange. First 'O' in 'CORREOS' broken on bottom right corner. Circle on bottom left broken on bottom left corner. Circle on bottom right has a crack in middle on left side. Thick eyebrow not showing the line details as on the original stamp. Shading around the central bust is crude and appears more condensed.
