2-REALES



Gooding #17F1. The 'C' of 'CORREOS' is too near to the left frame and too tall and the second 'R' is too large. The second 'R' of 'INTERIOR' is too wide at the bottom. The circle almost touches the line at the top and bottom, with only one row of the fish-scale network above the top of the central circle and two below the bottom of it. The Queen's lip is pointed somewhat upwards. The bust is much too pointed. There is a vertical line between 'O' and the first 'R' of 'CORREOS' and between 'O' and second 'R' in 'INTERIOR'. Known unused or cancelled.



Gooding #17F2. Issued in deep blue. The dotted circle and ornaments at the sides are very poor. The background is composed of white dots instead of semi-circles. Known unused or cancelled.
