The purpose of the Index is to provide easy identification of most IPPS articles for the general Philippine collector. The Index would not have been possible without the many helpful suggestions and access to historical IPPS documents provided by Bob Yacano, Bill Oliver, and Doug Lehmann.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE INDEX

The Index includes articles from the International Philippine Philatelic Society's official publication that has had three name changes since inception: *Philippine Philatelic Newsletter* (PPNL) (July 1974-November/December 1975) published in Manila, *Philippine Philatelic News* (PPN) (January/February 1976-Fourth Quarter 1990) published in Manila or Eden, NY, and *Philippine Philatelic Journal* (PPJ) (First Quarter 1991 to present) published in Eden, NY and Toast, NC. The earlier publications contained both newsletter-type articles and notices, as well as research-type articles. Beginning in the mid-1970s, the journals contained primarily research-related articles. Appendix A is a list of the IPPS publications included in this Index.

WHAT'S NOT INCLUDED IN THE INDEX

The Index does not include most notices (e.g., IPPS meetings, dues, etc.), articles on exhibits and exhibitions (except when they contain important historical or postal history information), most editorials, and notices of new issue releases. The Index also does not include the contents of other IPPS publications: the *Philippine New Issue Updates* (September 1985-October 1987), *IPPS News* (October/December 1981-1991), and the *IPPS Newsletter* (1991 to present). These publications could be incorporated into the Index at a future date.

FORMAT

The Index is divided into 16 sections (by Era and special subjects), which are further sub-divided into topics. Although many articles could

be listed under more than one section and/or topic, an article was listed "first" under its "primary" topic, and then, only if deemed absolutely necessary, was it cited under another related topic. This balanced approach was taken to avoid creating a "monster" all-inclusive index, yet providing an index that is reasonably easy to use. The articles are listed chronologically under each section and topic. The "Postal History" topic includes articles on postal routes, postal rates, postal service (airmail service is in a separate Section), or the story of a cover (s). Generally, articles on the history of a particular stamp or stamp series are included under the "Stamps" topic. The format for listing each article is as follows:

- title
- [additional information, if needed]
- author
- publication
- date
- volume
- number
- page.

In cases where the title of the article does not clearly indicate its contents, a short, parenthetical description of the topic in brackets was added after the title to assist the reader.
