



Cover stamped in Manila on January 1, 1870 to Madrid. It was franked with two provisional stamps at $6\frac{2}{8}$ Centavos de Peso. The stamps were overprinted vertically, the left stamp shows the variety of a small period under "e" of "Fe". They were tied by a Parilla cancel.

Two provisional stamps at $6\frac{2}{8}$ Centavos de Peso paying for single cover rate, up to 4 Adarmes, to Spain.



Envelope stamped Manila April 24, 1869 Manila to the Spanish capital. One day later, the cover was carried on the Spanish steamer *Patiño* on its way to Europa via Hong Kong. It arrived on May 18 in Madrid.

A provisional stamp at $12\frac{4}{8}$ Centavos de Peso, tied by Parilla cancel, paying for single cover rate, up to 4 Adarmes, to Spain.
