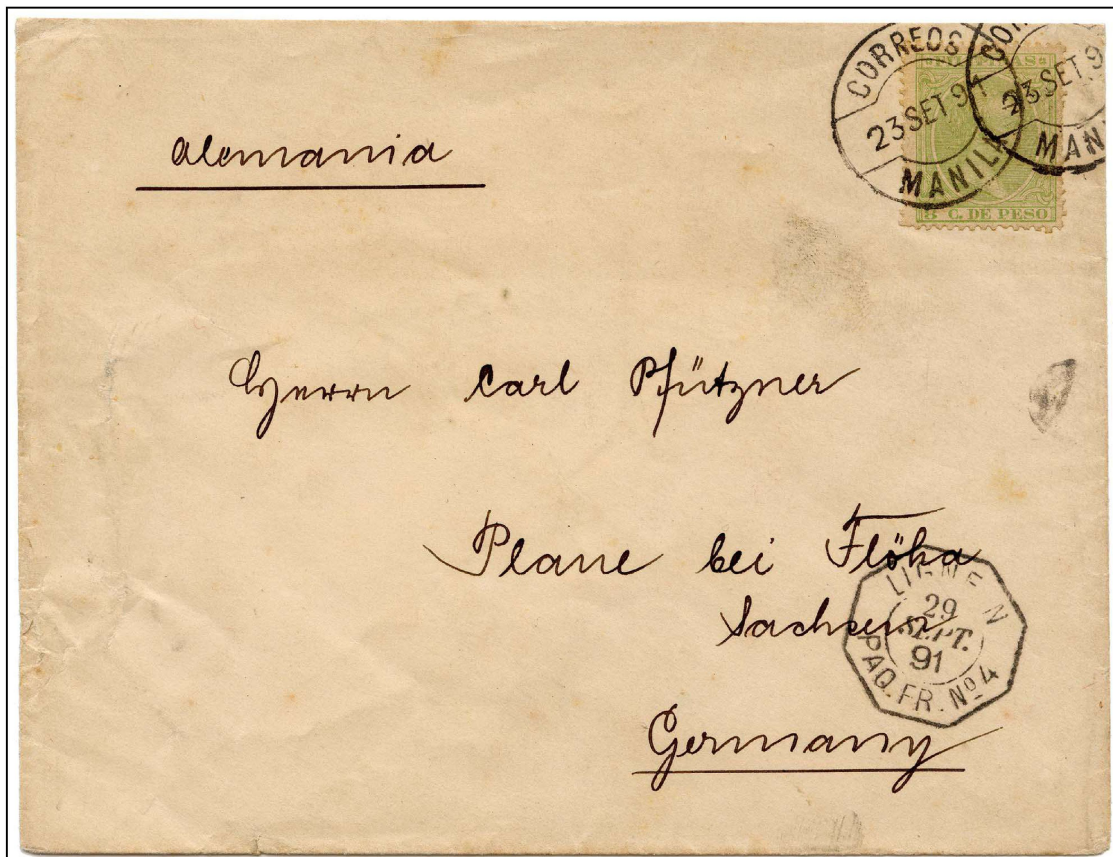


King Alfonso XIII, 1890s

1890, Manila to Southport, United Kingdom
1891, Manila to Plaue, German Empire



Envelope sent in Manila December 22, 1890 to Southport, United Kingdom. It is franked with four stamps at 2 Centavos de Peso, issued in 1890. The cover was shipped to Hong Kong and afterwards carried by a British steamship. On January 28, 1891 it arrived in Southport.



Cover sent from Manila to Plaue, German Empire. The stamp at 8 Centavos de Peso, issued in 1890, was cancelled on September 23, 1891 by the "CORREOS / MANILA" date stamp. It went to Singapore and was then carried by the French vessel *Yangtse* where it got a Paquebot date stamp. It arrived in Flöha on October 24.

The rate to nearly all UPU member nations was 8 Centavos de Peso for 15 grams or fraction thereof.
