

Postcard, issued 1892, sent from Manila to Erfurt, German Empire. The card was tied by "CORREOS / MANILA" cancels on January 25, 1895. It arrived in Erfurt on February 26.

Postcard, sent from Manila to New York. The postage was paid by one 2 Centavos and a 5 Milesimas de Peso pair, issued in 1894 The stamps tied were by "CORREOS / MANILA" cancels on October 2, 1895. It was cancelled in San Francisco on November 2 and in New York on November 8, 1895.

Rare, privately prepared postcard, of which the earliest known.
