

Cover sent from Manila August 21, 1893 to Knockin, United Kingdom.

From Singapore, the letter was carried by a British steamship. On September 25, 1893 it arrived in Oswestry.

Properly franked by an 8 Centavos stamp, issued 1892, paying the UPU rate at 8 Centavos de Peso.



Registered cover Lingayen to Erfurt, German Empire. Three 2 Centavos stamps, issued 1894, stamped June 30, 1895 by "CORREOS / LINGAYEN" cancel and one 10 Centavos stamp, issued 1894, tied by registration marking.

The German registration label indicates that the cover went via France. The cover arrived in Erfurt on 8. August.

Single weight cover 8 Centavos de Peso plus registration fee 8 Centavos, total 16 Centavos franking.
