

Unsealed cover sent as circular from Manila May 12, 1897 to Auckland, New Zealand. Uncommon destination, three covers recorded to New Zealand from the Spanish period. Backstamped in Singapore on May 17, 1897.

Block of four of 5 Milesimas de Peso impresos stamps issued in 1896 to cover the single-weight overseas circular rate (20 Milesimas equivalent to 2 Centavos de Peso).

New Zealand was Member of the UPU from October 1, 1891 as a British Colony of Australasia, therefore the weight for a single-weight overseas circular, weighing a maximum of 50 grams, was 2 Centavos de Peso effective from January 1, 1886 to December 31, 1897.
