

Postal stationary at 5 Milesimas de Peso (equivalent to 0.5 Centavos de Peso) sent in Manila on May 25, 1898. The cancel was set incorrectly, as it states June. The Spanish post was still functioning at this time but had trouble to dispatch outbound mail. Most of the mail was carried privately to Hong Kong. The card was cancelled there on May 30. It was transported to Marseille via Suez by the French ship *Laos*.

Accepted as printed matter as it has only a signature on the back. The 5 Milesimas de Peso overseas printed matter rate was effective from January 1, 1898. **Only recorded use without additional franking.**



2 Centavos de Peso card with added 1 Peso Centavos de stamp, both issued 1898, sent from Manila Zürich, to Switzerland. It was cancelled by the worn "CORREOS / MANILA" cancel on March 24, 1898. The card was carried by the Spanish ship España to Singapore.

The postcard was cancelled in Zürich on April 22. In Zürich, it was undeliverable.

Postcard rate to all UPU countries except Spain was during the whole Spanish period 3 Centavos de Peso.
