

3 Centavos de Peso postcard, sent from Manila to Amsterdam, Netherlands. It was cancelled by the worn "CORREOS / MANILA" cancel on February 17, 1898. The postcard was cancelled in Amsterdam on March 20. The small cancel with number was applied by the mailman. The red postage due note has been crossed out, as it was presumably applied in error. **Only recorded usage of this card.**Provenance: Nigel Gooding



Paid reply postal card, message half, at 3 Centavos de Peso.

The card was cancelled on January 19, 1898 in Manila. It was sent to Wil, Switzerland, where it arrived about one month later.

It is remarkable that a picture of a Manila city gate is pasted on the back. The sender noted on the front that no picture cards were available for purchase. Only known picture postcard of the Spanish period.

Only recorded used message half of the 3 Centavos card.
