Front of a wrapper sent from Manila to Barcelona, Spain. It was franked by two 1 Centavo de Peso stamps. The stamps were cancelled on March 12, 1898 by the "CORREOS / MANILA" date stamp.

2 Centavos de Peso postage were used to cover a quintuple printed matter rate, weighing a maximum of 250 grams. The printed matter rate to Spain was set to 4 Milesimas de Peso per 50 grams went into effect on January 1, 1898. Only one printed matter item to Spain is known from this period.
